

Beech Acres Parenting Center Evaluating Anderson Township Property

Cincinnati, Ohio – Beech Acres Parenting Center is carefully evaluating the best use of its largest physical asset, the 17.6 acres of property it owns and occupies at 6881 Beechmont Avenue in Anderson Township. Beech Acres moved to the Anderson Township property in 1949 after a century on Burnet Avenue in the city of Cincinnati.

"The land in Anderson Township where we are currently headquartered is our largest physical asset and we need to evaluate the best way forward to maximize its full potential while being responsible stewards of all of our financial assets, enabling us to better serve our community," said Brittany Speed, chief financial officer for Beech Acres.

Beech Acres has partnered with the Cincinnati office of Cushman & Wakefield to help evaluate all best possible options for the property. The organization also plans to seek input from their staff during the entire process.

"This is an important decision that we will not rush," said Laura Mitchell, president and CEO of Beech Acres. "We will carefully consider all options concerning the property before making and announcing a final decision."

Beech Acres Parenting Center has evolved in recent years, adopting modern approaches that meet parents where they are; in schools, pediatric offices, workplaces, and in the community. The organization would ideally like a permanent headquarters that offers an inviting space with easy access for clients and employees from across the Greater Cincinnati region and beyond. The organization is unlikely to make any changes in Q1 of FY2023, which begins in July.

Regardless of what decision is made concerning the Anderson Township property, Beech Acres' critically important services will continue with no disruptions.

"Our work, which involves combining science and compassion to deliver innovative solutions to the adults in children's lives in Greater Cincinnati and beyond, will continue uninterrupted," Mitchell said. "Ultimately it is our goal to better leverage our resources to serve more kids and families."
