## BUILDING A LIFE OF CARING AND GRATITUDE

Losing her mother at age 9 and her father the following year clearly changed the trajectory of Lucille Cicco Haines' life.

Growing up in the Over-the-Rhine neighborhood, Lucille came to the "country" to live at the new General Protestant Orphan Home on Beechmont Avenue from age 12 until high school graduation at 18.

A resident of Lueders Hall, Lucille worked in the Infirmary and developed her love of medicine under the

tutelage of the staff nurse. When her stepbrother later expressed his regret (Roy was 12 years her senior) for leaving her at the orphanage, Lucille responded: "It was the nicest thing you ever did for me."

Her memories of the orphanage included attending and graduating from high school, developing her life-long love for the Cincinnati Reds, and sneaking out of Lueders with her best friend to have a smoke in the field.

After graduation, Lucille landed a job at a local hospital - which paid for her RN degree. Following in the footsteps of her mother, she had a career as a nurse for 42 years, in Cincinnati, Florida and Indiana. During her midwife training in Hazard, Kentucky, Lucille

delivered a baby on the kitchen table.

Lucille married her soul mate David Haines in 1970 and moved to Lafayette, Indiana where she built her life around her step and grandchildren, her nursing career, her love of God and her endlessly optimistic zest for life.

And she never forgot the people and place that provided the foundation from which to grow and thrive.

A life-long donor to Beech Acres, in 2010, Lucille told Board Member Dave Wallace that she would give to the agency "til the day I die". In fact, Lucille exceeded that goal by naming Beech Acres as a beneficiary in her will, ensuring children have the support they need to thrive.

Lucille was a spitfire with an optimistic view on life. She believed in living it to the fullest during the time she was here. "There is no use crying over spilt milk" was a motto she embraced daily.

Her strengths of perseverance, hope, zest, and love built a life of joy, caring, and gratitude.

A collector of angels herself, Lucille Haines is certainly a Beech Acres angel. Her unwavering support changed children's lives for the better and her zest for life inspired all who knew her.

"Beech Acres saved my life. Without it, I would have been on the streets, and I want to help Beech Acres help others."

# BUILDING STRONGER RELATIONSHIPS



*One family was struggling with two wildly different teenagers, negative self-talk, and a lack of responsibility.*

A family was referred to a Parent Connect® parenting specialist by their pediatrician to address some challenges they were facing raising two very different teenage boys.

One of their sons had always been gifted academically and talented with sports, but as he grew older things became more challenging which led to a defeatist attitude and negative self-talk. Their other son was the opposite, demonstrating overconfidence that led to a total lack of responsibility and accountability. The parents were struggling to connect with their sons and find a way to move forward.

Through parent coaching, the parents were encouraged to

acknowledge and validate their sons' feelings rather than ignoring them. They discussed ways to approach accountability more warmly than directly and authoritatively. Through these sessions the family discovered effective ways to parent both of their sons, strengthen their relationship with their children, and create a clear vision for their parenting journey.

## BUILDING A BRIGHT FUTURE



*During her junior year, a student's future was disrupted when she discovered that she was pregnant.*

This young woman was near the top of her class and had a bright future. Once she became pregnant, her future was in doubt. After giving birth, she began to struggle during her senior year. She had attendance issues, behavioral issues, and her grades began to suffer.

This student wanted to succeed in school and as a parent, but felt desperate, guilty and alone. Help came through participation in Beyond the Classroom™. Working with a therapist, the student was given the space she needed to unpack and process her experiences and to address her traumas from her past. She worked with her therapist to develop a plan to tackle school and to prioritize her needs as a student and as a new mother.

A Family Peer Support Provider also helped her get connected to resources to support her wellbeing, including baby support, food, housing and utilities.

Today she and her child are doing well. The student was able to graduate and begin college. Her child is healthy and thriving. She expressed that she felt validated as a student and as a parent. This allowed her to see her experience not as a barrier to be overcome, but as an opportunity to love her child and herself.

- 47% of students receiving behavioral health services improved (industry average 35-40%)

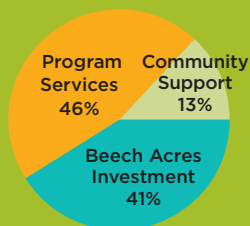

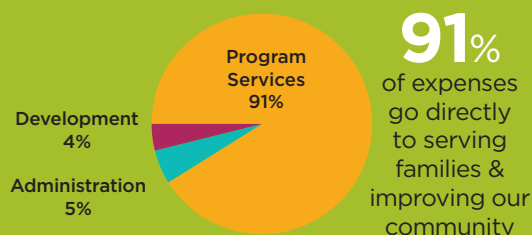

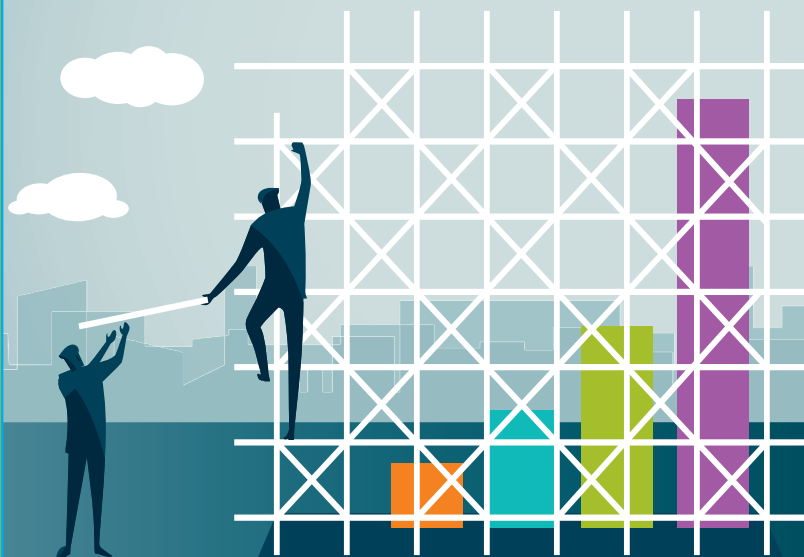
