Problem:

Social & emotional skills, including self-awareness, self-management and empathy do not come naturally to all children. These are skills that can be taught and encouraged to combat bullying and even suicide.

The pandemic has only made things more complicated. A report which surveyed more than 1,400 parents and nearly 900 early childhood educators in Massachusetts,

Our Solution:

Leveraging the science of positive psychology and mindfulness, The Character Effect™ creates a common language for teachers, parents and students to celebrate character strengths and learn to be present in the moment by utilizing skills such as self-management and self-awareness. found that just over 50% of parents said they have seen a negative impact on their child's social-emotional development.

Early childhood educators teaching younger children have noticed similar trends: **77% of those** educators who observed changes said they've been negative, including more temper tantrums, sadness or crying and difficulty separating from parents.

Unlike other programs, **The Character Effect[™] starts first with the teachers** – encouraging them to recognize their own strengths and teaching the self-care tools that so many teachers need right now.

The Character Effect Impact Report: 2021-2022



Overall, teachers indicated that they had a positive experience with The Character Effect[™] during the 2021-2022 school year. The table below shows the percentages of teachers who indicated that they saw the following improvements somewhat, quite a bit, or a lot, as a result of participating in the program, with over half of teachers seeing at least some improvement for each outcome.

Student Impact

All of this effort at the end of the day is for the students. **And it is working!** Across the program, **49% of students improved their social & emotional skills!**

The normed survey sorts students into 3 different 'buckets' – already strong in SEL [Strength], typical skill set for their grade [Typical] and could use additional support [Need]. **Teachers recognized improvement in 67% of students in the Needs group from the Fall survey to Spring! #strengthofteamwork**
